## *Graduate Schedule of Tuition and Fees*

**Fall 2024 & Spring 2025 Tuition Rates Approval**  
**Approved by the UNC Board of Governors in March 2024**



As a member institution of the UNC System, Appalachian State University's methods of calculation and rates of tuition and course-related fees must be approved by the UNC Board of Governors. Miscellaneous service charges are approved at the campus level by The Appalachian State University Chancellor.

## **Tuition and Fees for FALL and SPRING (each term)**

### **Tuition**

As required by the UNC Board of Governors, all students will be charged tuition on a per-credit-hour basis using the approved annual rate divided by 24 for undergraduate students and 18 for graduate students. The exception for students in a Fixed Tuition Cohort per North Carolina General Statute 116-143.9. For more information related to fixed tuition, see the [NC Fixed Tuition Guarantee page](#). Rates for students in a fixed tuition cohort are found below under the subheading *Fixed Tuition Cohorts*.

### **Fees**

Although the General Assembly provides for most of the instructional costs of institutions through state appropriations, institutions generally rely entirely on student fees to finance activities, services, and some facilities that enhance the overall student experience. These fees are considered part of the enrollment cost in a program and do not reflect the provision of any specific service. Fees are assessed based on the program the student is enrolled in and student level (undergraduate or graduate). Miscellaneous Fees are approved by the Appalachian State University Chancellor. Some Miscellaneous fees may not be fully approved at the time of the creation of this Tuition and Fee Schedule.

**App State Online Programs:** Students enrolled in a program designated as an App State Online Program will be assessed fees at the App State Online Program rates. These fees are charged pursuant to considerations surrounding the functionality of online programs. This also includes App State Online Programs that meet at an offsite location (The Hickory Campus is Considered part of our Main Campus). Online programs may not provide access to all campus services and facilities. Students enrolled in an App State Online program may contact the Office of Student Accounts to opt into the Health Services Access Fee. If a student opts in, the full-time rate will be charged regardless of the number of hours that the student is enrolled. All courses will be assessed at the App State Online fee schedule if a student is enrolled in an App State Online program.

**Boone/Hickory Campus Programs** Program-based fees are required for students enrolled in a program designated for the Boone or Hickory campus, regardless of participation in or use of program-based services or facilities. The only exception to these required fees is that a student may opt out of the book rental fee. Please contact the campus bookstore for opt-out deadlines and to request to opt-out. If a student is enrolled in a Boone/Hickory campus program, all courses will be assessed at the Boone/Hickory campus program fee schedule.

If you have questions regarding which fee structure applies to your program, please consult your advisor or the Registrar's Office (for undergraduate) and Graduate Studies (for all other levels). Once tuition and fees are charged, the Office of Student Accounts can explain the charges. We cannot answer why a specific program is designated as App State Online or Boone/Hickory campus program fees.

## Graduate Cost Detail

*Fees are standard for all students based on the schedule below. ASU fees are established and approved by the University and/or the State of North Carolina UNC Board of Governors*

### Fee Structure –

**Athletic Fees** – Provides funds for intercollegiate athletic programs and facilities.

**Health Services** – Provides funding for operations and maintenance of health facilities.

**Student Activities** – Provide for non-academic operations and maintenance of student activities, services, and facilities.

**Educational & Technology** – Provides specialized supplies and services as well as scientific and informational technology equipment and software not provided by state appropriations.

**Safety & Security** – To implement security priority needs for the University.

**Indebtedness** – To retire university debt.

**Special Fees** – Provide funds for specific needs not financed by other sources. This currently includes a transportation fee.

**Book Rental** – Students can opt out of this fee. Students should either contact the bookstore for more information or see [The Book Rental Program Website](#).
